PLAYER'S CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

(Note: This Policy is taken from the Australian Baseball Federation (ABF) Member Protection Policy (MPP) {Section D4} and is subject to alteration without notice as per ABF Updates of the MPP. The most current version of the policy will be available from Baseball Australia and will overrule this policy if changes are made.)

In addition to the DBA's General Code of Behaviour, players must meet the following requirements in regard to conduct during any activity held or sanctioned by the ABF, a member association (DBA), or an affiliated club.

- (1) Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, coaches, officials and spectators.
- (2) Do not tolerate acts of aggression.
- (3) Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow players and competitors.
- (4) Care for and respect the equipment provided to you as part of your program.
- (5) Be frank and honest with your coach concerning illness and injury and your ability to train fully within the program requirements.
- (6) At all times avoid intimate relationships with your coach.
- (7) Conduct yourself in a professional manner relating to language, temper and punctuality.
- (8) Maintain high personal behaviour standards at all times.
- (9) Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the official, making all appeals through the formal process and respecting the final decision.
- (10) Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training.
- (11) Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
- (12) Cooperate with coaches and staff in development of programs to adequately prepare you for competition at the highest level.
